

EARLY GRADUATION

A student who wishes to graduate from high school in less time than the ordinary eight (8) semester, grade 9-12 sequence, may request permission to complete graduation requirements on an alternate schedule.

The student that wishes to graduate early, along with their parent/guardian, will consult with the high school guidance personnel to develop a graduation plan. The student's intention to accomplish this shall be stated in writing to the principal. In addition, a letter of support from the parent/guardian must accompany the student's request. The request letters to the principal are to be submitted no later than six months prior to the anticipated completion of the required high school program and board approval.

A student who graduates early must complete all graduation requirements established by the Board of Education. The early-out graduate will be awarded an official diploma at a regular Board of Education meeting. Upon early graduation, the student will no longer be able to participate in any school activities or events; however, the student will be allowed to take part in the graduation ceremony of their respective, initial class if they submit a request in writing to the principal at least sixty (60) days prior to their respective, initial graduation date.
